

VISITATION GUIDELINES & SCHEDULE

Please review the guidelines below before you visit. Many of these guidelines are in response to state and federal laws and regulations, but all seek to protect the safety of our patients, staff, and visitors. If you have any questions regarding these guidelines, please ask a member of our staff.

- All visitors are required to check in with the receptionist & arrive 10 minutes prior to visitation.
- Visitors age 18 & older are required to show a valid ID during check-in. Visitors ages 14–17 must be accompanied by an adult. Children under 14 are not permitted to visit.
- · Only two visitors are permitted at a time.
- Visiting times may change without notice due to unit or patient needs.
- Purses, backpacks, bags, cellphones, food, & drink are not permitted in the visiting area. Lockers are available upon request.
- If you are bringing items to leave with a patient, please give all items to staff when you enter the lobby for check-in.
- Clergy, caseworkers, court representatives, & attorneys may visit at any time.

The following items are considered contraband and are not allowed in the hospital:

- · Alcohol or any drug-related paraphernalia
- Sharp objects, such as razors, scissors, glass bottles, mirrors, needles, pins, aluminum cans, keys, paper clips, underwire bras, & any item with sharp edges or which could be broken to create sharp edges
- Shoelaces, belts, pantyhose, rope, headbands, elastic bandages, clothing with drawstrings or long ties, & any item with an electric cord
- Matches & lighters, aerosol cans, & fireworks
- TVs, stereos, video games, CD players, computers, & cellphones
- · Cameras or any type of audio or visual recording device
- Weapons, candles or incense, & plastic bags
